Chili Team Rules:

REGISTRATION CUT OFF DATE March 20th, 2010

This is a fundraiser for the Aubrey Fire Department Auxiliary and should be treated as such an event. Please cooperate with all rules to ensure the success and safety of all.

- Each Chili team's entry should be no less than one full crock pot of chili. One 8oz cup will be actually judged and the other portion should be available for samples to the general public which have been identified as wearing a colored bracelet. You may make more of the same entry for the same registration fee, however every different recipe entry requires separate registration fee.
- Each Chili team is responsible for their area that they will be assigned on the morning of event day, and only by the event coordinators. There are no holding of spots until registration received. Cut off of number of teams will be determined by space available. Get your registration in early!
- This is NOT a sanctioned chili cook off, and decisions of our volunteer community judges are final. All awards are in the form of trophies, non-cash value.

- Each team must bring their own cooking devices, utensils, table, chairs, **and a 10 x 10 canopy is required for your team site.**
- Each team must have a lid on the chili and must use sanitary serving utensils.
- Each team is responsible for keeping their site area clean and sanitary through out the event and must clean up team site afterwards.
- Each team is required to check in and set up NO LATER than 10AM and must stay onsite until 3PM. Tear down is not to begin until 3PM please. Upon arrival and check in, proceed to your designated area, unload and remove all vehicles. There are NO vehicles allowed in event site NO exception! (Check-in can begin as early as 8am, not before)
- Each team will be required to sign the waiver of liability in which all teammates must sign, and adhere to all safety rules. Children must be supervised and not allowed to run freely around any of the cooking sites. No pets are allowed.
- Each team may choose to prepare their chili at home and bring it to the site, or they may prepare and actually cook onsite. Keep in mind, if the Burn ban is in effect the day of the event we will not be allowed to have any cooking with open flames. Plan accordingly.
- We strongly encourage decorations and space presentation as we will have a fun award for Best Decorations. You may serve crackers, corn bread, Fritos, toppings, etc. with your chili.
- Concession cabin will be selling hotdogs, soft drinks, ice tea and water. A bake sale will be selling homemade baked goods for taking home, these are other components to our fundraiser. You may not sell anything at your cooking site.
- No ice chest will be allowed except for carrying your fresh ingredients if you are cooking on site. No outside drinks of any kind allowed to be brought into the event. Please buy them at our concession stand.
- EVERYONE needs to purchase the \$5 (adults) or \$2 (children 3-12yrs) sample bracelets if you are going to sample/eat ANY chili, including your own. This is a fundraiser and the success of it is based on selling all of the chili. Please make sure you, your team and your family follows these rules. Even our Volunteers are required to purchase a bracelet to sample the chili!
- Judging will be at 12noon and information when you arrive will be given to the exact procedure. A quick mandatory “Cooks Meeting” will take place at 10:00 am and all teams with all teammates are required to be in attendance.
- This is a rain or shine event with no refunds given. Pre–event tickets are being sold and a rain plan will go into effect 7 days prior to event if necessary. We will keep you informed.
